Swiss AI Summit 2026 Announced: Building Europe's Leading AI Ecosystem in Zurich

A global AI conference connecting industry, technology, and policy through a year-round ecosystem focused on real-world AI use cases.

Zurich, Switzerland: The Swiss AI Summit has officially announced its 2026 edition, bringing together global leaders from industry, technology, and policy to explore how artificial intelligence is being implemented in real-world environments.

Hosted on November 16, 2026, at Kunsthaus Zürich, the Swiss AI Summit is designed around four core thematic blocks (Finance, Healthcare, Manufacturing, and Business & Strategy), delivered across one main stage and eight specialized workshops, all focusing on the following main topics:

- **Business & Strategy:** Examining the future of work and leadership through the lens of Geopolitics, Quantum Computing, and Cybersecurity.
- **Financial Services & Insurance (FSI):** Addressing the evolution of Banking, Fintech, and Real Estate in a data-driven world.
- **Healthcare & Life Sciences:** Focusing on MedTech and medical innovation in collaboration with confirmed leading Swiss hospitals.
- **Manufacturing:** Exploring the frontier of Industrial AI, robotics, retail, and the optimization of global supply chains.

The 2026 edition will center on turning AI strategy into execution. Key themes include AI use cases, enterprise implementation, governance, and scaling challenges across industries such as finance, healthcare, manufacturing, telecommunications, marketing, and legal tech.

Participants can expect a curated mix of:

- Meetings
- Keynotes and panel discussions
- Hands-on workshops and use case sessions
- Closed-door executive roundtables
- High-level networking experiences, including an exclusive Gala Dinner
